

Hwy 280 – I-94 to Hwy 36/I-35W

ST. PAUL, MINNEAPOLIS, LAUDERDALE, ROSEVILLE

MnDOT is making significant improvements to Hwy 280 from I-94 in St. Paul to Hwy 36/I-35W in Roseville in 2026, 2028 and beyond.

About the 2026 project

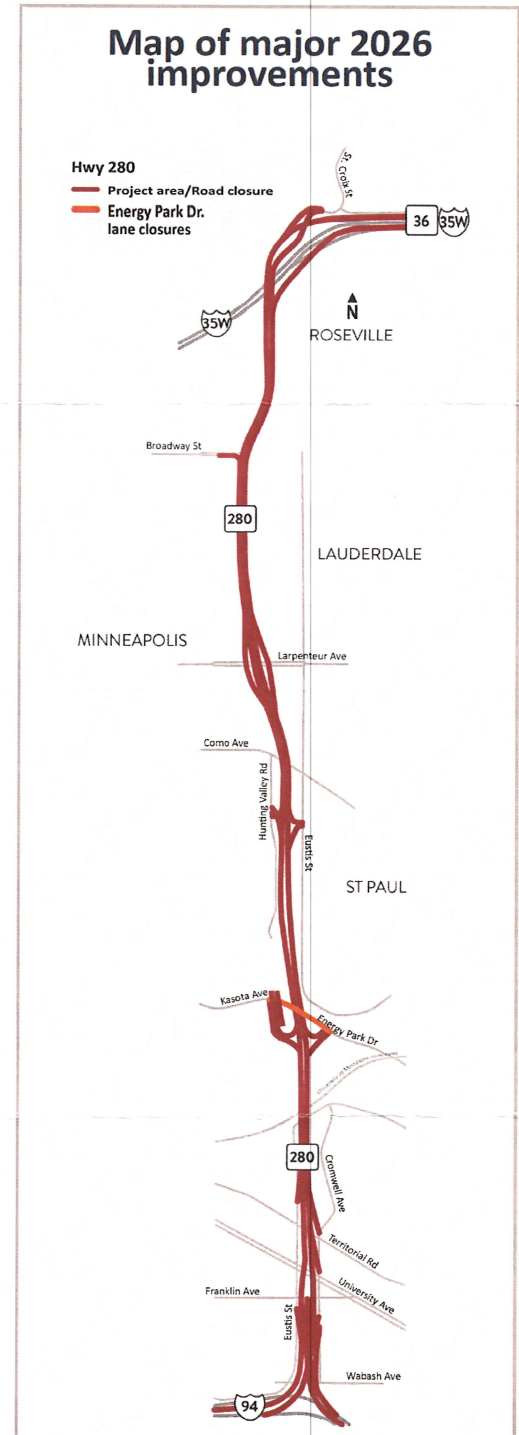
Beginning as soon as April 13 through fall 2026, MnDOT will resurface Hwy 280, repair bridges, repair and resurface ramps and make additional improvements. Resurfacing of aging pavement on Hwy 280 will provide a smoother ride for motorists and extend the life of the highway.


2026 improvements include

- ▶ Resurface Hwy 280 pavement
- ▶ Repair bridges that carry Hwy 280 over other roads and facilities
- ▶ Repair and resurface ramps
- ▶ Repair drainage
- ▶ Install new traffic signs
- ▶ Replace guardrails

2026 traffic impacts

- ▶ All traffic impacts are tentative and weather dependent. Information about upcoming traffic impacts will be posted online as details become available.
- ▶ **Motorists can anticipate a full closure of Hwy 280, including ramps, from I-94 to Hwy 36/I-35W. Crews will open Hwy 280 at the beginning of the State Fair in late August. After the State Fair, MnDOT will make efforts to limit traffic impacts to lane and ramp closures through fall 2026.**
- ▶ Expect lane closures on Energy Park Dr. under Hwy 280.
- ▶ Cross streets will remain open except Broadway St. Access to Broadway St. from Hwy 280 will be closed from April to October 2026.
- ▶ The Metro Transit Bus Routes 30 and 33 will continue serving existing bus stops during construction, but bus schedules may be affected by construction. Visit metrotransit.org for the latest information.
- ▶ In addition to the posted detour, MnDOT will work with the public, businesses and stakeholders on detour guidance as needed. Please consider using Snelling Ave. for local detours.

About future improvements

Beginning as soon as spring 2028, MnDOT will continue to repair bridges, install new traffic signals and make safety and accessibility improvements for all who travel along and across Hwy 280. These improvements are still being finalized.

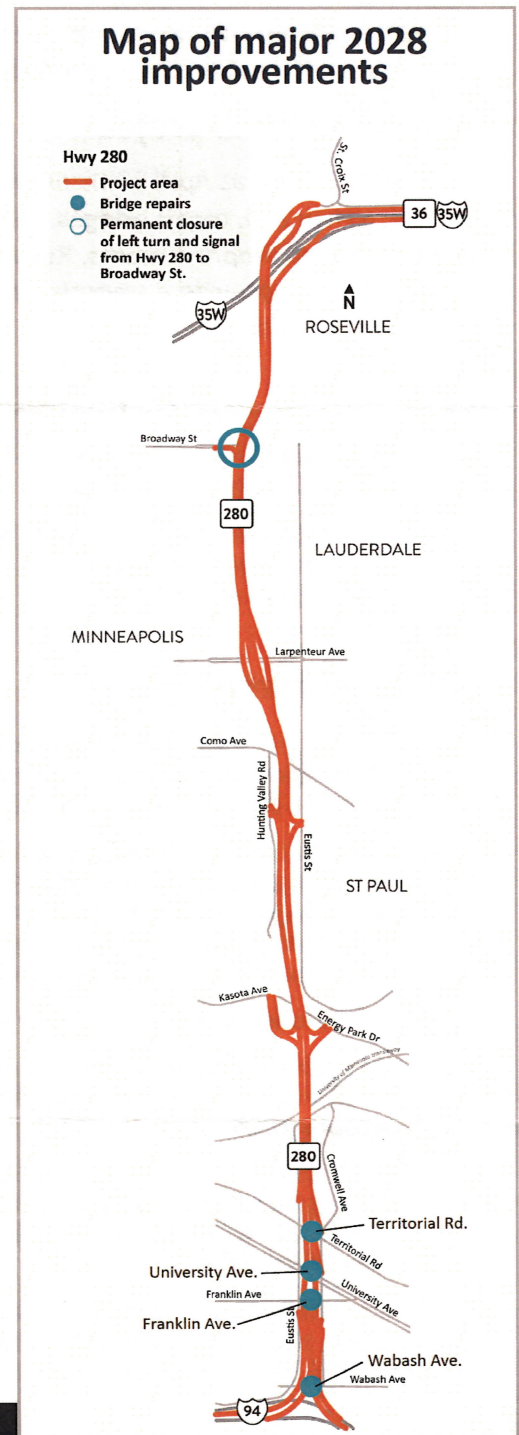
The northbound left turn to Broadway St. from Hwy 280 will permanently close to improve safety by reducing the number of serious high speed crashes and close calls at this traffic signal.

2028 and beyond improvements include

- ▶ Repair bridges that carry traffic over Hwy 280 in 2028 (see maps of improvements)
- ▶ Upgrade sidewalks to meet ADA requirements
- ▶ Install new traffic signals at Franklin Ave. and Territorial Rd.
- ▶ Additional safety and accessibility improvements to streets along and across Hwy 280 are being analyzed and considered

2028 traffic impacts

- ▶ All traffic impacts are tentative and weather dependent. Information about upcoming traffic impacts will be posted online as details become available.
- ▶ Motorists can expect periodic street and bridge closures as shown on the map. MnDOT will make efforts to alternate street and bridge closures.
- ▶ **The northbound left turn to Broadway St. from Hwy 280 will permanently close. Right turns from southbound Hwy 280 to Broadway St. will remain open.**
